





WHY TRAVEL WITH US?



HOW TO BOOK



- (1) Contact the Rome Pilgrimages team for your free pilgrim kit on 1800 753 959 or pilgrimage@sydneycatholic.org
- Register: We will send you a registration form to complete. Once you decide to come on the pilgrimage, send us the complete registration form and your \$300 deposit to secure your place on pilgrimage.
- Confirm: Rome Pilgrimages will contact you once we have reached the required minimum number (20) of booked pilgrims. We advise you not to finalise your airfares, extra accommodation, etc. until we confirm that your pilgrimage will proceed.
- Book Airfares: Pilgrims must organise their own airfares. We are happy to refer you to a travel agent if you don't have one. Any additional accommodation outside the official pilgrimage period will need to be arranged directly with Domus Australia.
- Final Payment: An invoice will be sent for the balance of payment once the pilgrimage is confirmed to go ahead. Your pilgrimage package must be paid in full eight weeks before the pilgrimage starts.
- Official Pilgrim Departure Pack: The Rome Pilgrimages' Team will post your pilgrim's pack to get you ready for your pilgrimage to Rome. If you are leaving earlier than the pilgrimage commences, let us know so you can receive your pack before you leave.
